American Citizen Party

National Sales Tax

An excise tax that complies with the rule of uniformity set forth in Article I Section 8 of the Constitution

“... all duties, imposts and excises shall be uniform throughout the United States.”

Tax rate and taxable items are established by Congress

Preliminary estimates project a tax rate between 15%-20%

Eliminates all paycheck withholding

Abolishes the I.R.S.

“Vote With Your Dollars[®]”

Creates an opt-in system that allows every American to allocate their sales tax dollars to the four tax revenue accounts in any proportion they choose.

These allocation percentages are embedded into credit, debit, and convenience cards and are automatically applied at the point-of-sale terminals of retail stores.

Example

Example 1

One person buys a \$1,000 taxable item at a retail store.

\$1,000 purchase with 20% sales tax rate

$$\$1,000 \times 20\% = \$200 \text{ tax}$$

Several people with different allocation percentages buy a \$1,000 taxable item at a retail store.

\$1,000 purchase with 20% sales tax rate

$$\$1,000 \times 20\% = \$200 \text{ tax}$$

Establish a 21st Century Naming Convention for Legislation

Names are based on the **Congressional Body** from which the Bill originates, the **Spending Category** from which funds are to be appropriated, and the **Bill Number**.

HR = House of Representatives

S = Senate

Example

The House Subcommittee on Space and Aeronautics introduces a bill to appropriate tax dollars for a bill to fund research for a new rocket engine.

Place Internal Accounting Controls on Congress

Tax revenues from one account shall NOT be used to fund a program in another.

Earmarks and amendments shall NOT be added to non-related legislation.

5. Continue to conduct petition drives in every state to ensure that American Citizen Party candidates' names are on every ballot.
6. Begin Bob McNeil's campaign for President.
